Not for Profit Accounting

The *Office of the Economic Development Board*, in conjunction with *Not for Profit Accounting Specialists* invite you to attend a free information session on the implementation of the Standard Chart of Accounts for the Not-for-Profit Sector. As you may be aware, from 1 July 2011 across all South Australian government departments, the SCOA will be implemented. The SCOA will be the

basis for preparing all funding acquittals in the future, and will for the first time provide a clear and consistent definition of income, expenditure and balance sheet accounts which are to be used for all funding acquittals across all departments. This session will provide an overview of the changes and the opportunity for you to compare your current chart of accounts to the Standard Chart of Accounts and highlight the changes that this may mean for your organisation. So bring along your chart of accounts and make the most of this opportunity to ensure that you and your organisation are on the front foot!
